Message from the President



2010 was an exciting year for Sudbury Rainbow Crime Stoppers. We celebrated 23 years as a Program during which tips from citizens have assisted in solving over 3,300 cases and recovering over \$44.8 million in stolen property and drugs.

In addition to holding our annual Tri-Force Regimental Fundraising Ball, "Tee off for Tips" Golf Tournament and "Race Against Crime" Night at the Races at Sudbury Downs, Sudbury Rainbow Crime Stoppers also participated in a Drive-In Movie at the New Sudbury Centre and the Emergency Services Appreciation BBQ hosted by Glenn Thibeault - MP, Sudbury.

Booths were set up at malls, businesses and schools in Sudbury and Elliot Lake so that we could promote the many successes of our Program and provide individuals with information on how to contact Crime Stoppers. The booths were manned by board members, police coordinators and volunteers who enjoyed speaking with people about the Program and answering their questions. In addition over 60 presentations to over 2,230 individuals on what Crime Stoppers is and how we can help were given to students, seniors and community organizations in Espanola, Manitoulin Island, Elliot Lake, Massey and Sudbury.

Sudbury Rainbow Crime Stoppers also partnered with the Greater Sudbury Police Service and other community organizations to bring Rick Osborne back to Sudbury to work with at-risk youth on a bike build project and speak at local schools. Rick shares his knowledge of addiction and street level crime as it relates to the drug, gang and violence issues that currently plague our communities.
