Copper Wire Alert

Copper theft has become one of the fastest growing forms of crime in the Province of Ontario.

The Greater Sudbury area has experienced numerous copper theft complaints from Hydro One, as well as other businesses.

In power lines, copper wire is used as a conductor for electricity. Contact with an energized power line can result in serious injury or death from electrocution.

We are requesting the public's assistance to identify these thieves, and those paying for the stolen metals.

These thefts threaten the safety of the general public and could negatively impact upon our the reliability of the services that utilize copper wire.

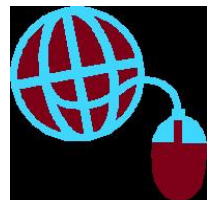
Child Internet Luring Project

Crime Stoppers is now partnering with the Ontario Provincial Police Child Internet Luring Project.

The Ontario Provincial Police, Child Pornography Section was formed in 1975 at the request of the Attorney General. There are currently 14 Ontario Provincial Police officers in the Child Pornography Section, one Detective Inspector, two Detective Sergeants and 11 Detective Constables.

The Child Pornography Section has the overall responsibility as the Provincial lead in such investigations, and investigates/prosecutes those persons who are responsible for making, importing, exporting, selling, distributing, accessing and possession of Child Pornography in the Province of Ontario. The Child Pornography Section of the Ontario Provincial Police assists other Police Services that do not have the technical resources/expertise to properly conduct "Child Pornography" investigations in their areas of jurisdiction.
