
Operating Aggregate Pit While Under Suspension Cost Owner \$2,500

A man from the Dwight Ontario area has been fined \$2,500 for a violation of the Aggregate Resources Act.

H. Kenneth Cunnington pleaded guilty to one count of operating an aggregate pit while his licence was under suspension. The pit was operated on at least three different occasions during the time his licence was suspended.

Court heard that in September 2009, the Ministry of Natural Resources Bracebridge office issued a suspension notice to Cunnington for failing to pay his 2008 tonnage fees. Inspections of the pit during the suspension period revealed that Cunnington had been operating the pit.

Justice of the Peace Susan Evans heard the case in Ontario Court of Justice, Bracebridge, on December 10, 2009.
