
Huntsville Man fined \$1,635 for Fisheries Related Offences

A Huntsville resident pleaded guilty to charges that he obstructed a conservation officer while on a fisheries patrol.

Jeremy Mieske was fined \$1,000 under the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act. Mieske was also fined \$240 for failing to stop for a conservation officer, \$155 for failing to update information on his Outdoor Card and \$240 for fishing without a licence.

Court heard that on September 6, 2009, Mieske was contacted by a conservation officer at the public boat launch off Skeleton Lake Rd 3. During the inspection, Mieske got into his vehicle and fled the location. Conservation officers later located Mieske.

Justice of the Peace Susan Evans heard the case in the Ontario Court of Justice, Huntsville, on November 6, 2009.
